Rahul says recent killings in J&K show govt failure on security front

New Delhi: Amid a spate of terrorist killings of innocent civilians in Kashmir, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi said the central government has failed on security front in the UT contrary to its claims after introducing notebandi and annulling special status for Jammu and Kashmir.

Rahul tweeted, "Incidents of violence are increasing in Kashmir. Terrorism was neither stopped by demonetisation nor by abrogation of Article 370 - the central government has completely failed to provide security. We strongly condemn these attacks on our Kashmiri brothers and sisters, and send our condolences to the families of the deceased." TNN

This assessment was shared at a meeting chaired by home minister Amit Shah here on Thursday to review the security situation in J&K in wake of the civilian killings. The meeting was attended by NSA Ajit Doval and heads of CRPF. BSF and intelligence agencies. A fine-

ing the need to keep a closer watch on youths susceptible to radicalization and in touch with terrorists, and gathering better intelligence on transfer and supplies of arms, is believed to have been discussed.

According to sources, Pa $kistan\text{-}based\,terror\,sponsors$ like Lashker-e-Taiha (LeT) Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) to step up infiltration into J&K since July Intelligence inputs however indicate that mostly local youths are being drafted to carry out attacks on 'soft' targets. which may occasionally include locals suspected to be 'informers'.

While it is claimed that some of these local recruits are affiliated with The Resistance Front (TRF), J&K police sources insist that with the top leadership of the outfit neutralised over the past few months, the TRF is only a smokescreen created by the LeT in order to maintain deniability and project terrorist attacks in J&K as an indigenous job. It is also associated with Pakistan's efforts to avert a 'blacklisting' by the Financial Action

A person was killed in police firing as the car he was travelling in ignored a police check point and tried running into the CRPF personnel on duty on Thursday evening. J&K Police said that CRPF personnel fired in self defence leading to killing of a person in Anantnag district in South Kashmir.

Officials said that a check point was established by 40 Bn CRPF at Monghal Bridge in Anantnag district. CRPF officials tried to intercept a suspected vehicle without registration number but it rushed towards the checking party. It was then challenged by the troops on duty, who fired in self defence.

The driver of the car managed to escape and one person was found dead inside it. Police said the identity of the deceased person is being verified. TNN

HAL delivers key semi-cryo propellant tank to Isro

Bengaluru: Defence PSU Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) on Thursday said that the heaviest semi-cryogenic propellant tank (SC120-LOX) it has ever fabricated has been delivered to Indian Space Research Organization (Isro).

"The semi cryo-liquid oxygen (LOX) tank, the first developmental welded hardware is a part of the SC120 stage intended for payload enhancement by replacing the L110 stage in existing GSLV-Mk3 launch vehicle," a statement issued here read.

Last year, HAL had delivered the biggest ever cryogenic liquid hydrogen tank (C32-LH2) which is four metres in diameter and eight metres in length, much ahead of contractual schedule.

"HAL has mastered skills and technologies required for fabricating welded propellant tanks. Till date, our aerospace division has delivered 244 propellant tanks and 95 water tanks to Isro for the space programmes of PSLV, GSLV Mk2 and GSLV Mk3 of diameter 2.1, 2.8 and 4 metres where the length of the tank varies from 2.5 metres to 8.0 metres," the PSU said.

HAL, a strategic partner of Isro for around five decades, has delivered critical structures, tankages, satellite structures for the PSLV. GSLV-Mk2 and GSLV-Mk3 launch vehicles.

"...Various new projects like PS2/GS2 integration, semi-cryo structure fabrication and manufacturing of cryo and semi cryo engines are being taken up at HAL, for which installation and commissioning of unique infrastructures are nearing completion," HAL added, Further, HAL also supported Isro on Crew Module Atmospheric Re-entry Experiment (CARE), Pad Abort Test (PAT) for Crew Escape for human space mission and is currently supplying hardware for full-fledged launch vehicle GSLV Mk3 for Gaganyaan.

Omar appeals not to flee 'out of fear', Mufti calls J&K Centre's 'hellhole'

Srinagar/Jammu: Amid fears of a rerun of the terrorist violence targeting Kashmiri Pandits in the 90s, politics parties across the spectrum on Thursday spoke of the "selective killings" in Srinagar since Tuesday as either a conspiracy to drive a wedge between communities or a reflection of "state failure" to protect the citizenry.

"On my part, I am making a heartfelt appeal to all those who will be thinking of leaving the valley out of fear. Please don't. We can't let the perpetrators of these terror attacks succeed in their evil designs by driving you out-.The overwhelmingly majority of us don't want you to go," National Conference vicepresident and ex-CM Omar Abdullah tweeted.

PDP's Mehbooba Mufti, also a former CM, blamed the Centre for "a minuscule minority" becoming terror targets. "GOI's claims of building a Naya Kashmir has actually turned it into a hellhole. It's sole interest is to use Kashmir as a milch cow for its electoral interests," she alleged. Mufti had issued a similar statement after prominent Kashmiri Pandit businessman Makhan Lal Bindroo was shot dead in his Srinagar pharmacy on Tuesday, saying "an utterly desensitised govt has devalued human lives & pushed J&K into further peril & chaos by its ruthless policies of collective punishment, all in the garb of security".

Union minister for minority affairs Mukhtar Abbas Nagyi assured minority communities in J&K that the Centre was committed to its "national duty" of protecting their lives and safeguarding their interest.
